The meeting was called to order by Secretary Shutes. Roll was taken. Jerry Counterman and Dan Olmsted were absent. Because Secretary Shutes and Treasurer Schaedig were the only two board members present there was not a quorum so no decisions could be made.

The minutes from the July meeting were read but could not be approved because there was not a quorum.

Chief Yaklin reported that the Fire Department is under investigation because a concerned citizen/fire department member called MIOCEA about various violations. Fines could be levied. We will know more when the investigation is complete.

Deputy Chief C. Merchant reported that the department has banned together to right any wrongs that may have occurred. They are cooperating in full with the investigation.

Bills were paid. Ocqueoc and Bearinger Townships are holding off on their second half of operating monies because the department has over \$33,000 in the checking account.

Due to the fact that this was an unofficial meeting, no old or new business could be discussed. There is the possibility that a special meeting will be called some time during the month of November. The next regular Fire Board Meeting will be held on January 6, 2011 at 7 P.M.
